Emergency Overview

Appearance: Salmon - light pink solid. **CAUTION!** May cause mechanical eye and skin irritation. May cause respiratory and digestive tract irritation. This is expected to be a low hazard for usual industrial handling.

Potential Health Effects

Eyes: Dust may cause mechanical irritation.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES:

Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, occasionally lifting the upper and lower eyelids. Get medical attention immediately.
