3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION:

Emergency Overview

Appearance: Dark red to brown solid. **CAUTION!** This is expected to be a low hazard for usual industrial handling. May cause eye and skin irritation. May cause respiratory and digestive tract irritation.
